


Hello,

## How do you use the “Bible Journal”?

We never have time, there are always things to do and they never end. It happens to all of us, but I invite you to set aside some time to be alone with God. Away from daily routines like housework, your work job, friends and family. If possible, get up an hour earlier than usual and make the most of that time.

*"God, my God, you are; at dawn I will look for you; my soul thirsts for you, my flesh longs for you..." Psalms 63:1 NLT*

Find a quiet place to read and study your Bible. It can be in your sofa, the kitchen table, your office, etc. try to stay away your room, especially your bed, because it may make you sleepy.

*"Getting up very early in the morning, while it was still very dark, he went out and went to a deserted place, and there he prayed." Mark 1:35 KJV*

Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding and enlighten your word as you read.

*"The exposition of his words gives us light and gives understanding to the simple." Psalm 119:130 NIV*

Write intentionally, this book will one day be your commentary. A book you can go back to and use as a reference, a book you will share with your loved ones, your friends, and your pastor.

*"Engrave these words in your heart and in your mind; bind them on your hands as a sign and wear them on your forehead as a mark.
